

SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP



"Leaders over you in the Lord's work."

- Parental role (not king, ruler).
- Take care of household & the people in it.
- Set direction, priorities, & activities of church.

"Work hard among you."

- Characterized by hard work, not "a title".
- Involves being with & ministering to people.
- Not disconnected from church life but entwined in it.

"Give you spiritual guidance."

- Disciple & teach those under their care.
- Admonish & correct (Discipline).
- Aren't afraid of difficult conversations.

HONOUR, RESPECT, LOVE

"Dear brothers and sisters," honour those who are your leaders in the Lord's work. They work hard among you and give you spiritual guidance. Show them great respect and wholehearted love because of their work."

To Honour is to see, pay attention to, acknowledge, and appreciate.

To Respect is to hold in high regard (inward & outward). Esteem. Speak highly of.

To Love is to have affection, compassion, take care of, and sacrifice self for.

PEOPLE PASTOR PEOPLE

"Live peacefully with each other. Brothers and sisters, we urge you to warn those who are lazy. Encourage those who are timid. Take tender care of those who are weak. Be patient with everyone."

"Lazy" – disruptive, disorderly, undisciplined, immature - WARN "Timid" – down, discouraged, those with "little soul" - ENCOURAGE "Weak" – the sick, poor, those with no social status - TENDER CARE

Paul lays the responsibility of the community on the community. People pastor people. Each, and not the leaders alone, must be aware of their responsibility to other people in the church and seek to help them.




